



## **Asbury Woods Summer Camp Positive Behavior Plan**

Asbury Woods strives to provide each child with a positive experience when they attend our summer camp programs. In order to maintain a fun, educational, welcoming, inclusive, and SAFE environment for everyone, all children are expected to abide by our camp behavior plan during camp and extended care. We encourage parents to discuss behavior expectations and consequences with their child prior to their first day of camp.

### **All Campers are expected to:**

Treat with respect,

All camp educators, camp assistantants, Asbury Woods staff and volunteers, and other campers, the building and the grounds, and the plants and animals that live at Asbury Woods and on the property.

Act with kindness,

By speaking with kind words. All forms of bullying, teasing, or disrespect towards others will not be tolerated.

By treating others the way you want to be treated.

Make responsible choices ,

By following directions of Asbury Woods Educators and Staff.

By staying with the group and staying on trails.

By using materials and equipment appropriately.

By doing what is right, what you ought to do.

By being accountable for your behaviors and obligations.

### **Consequences:**

We understand that children are learning in all aspects of their lives, and that learning appropriate behaviors is a process. At the same time, we are committed to maintaining a positive and safe camp environment for all. Our behavior plan is as follows:

## First occurrence

The camp educator will give the child a verbal reminder of expected behavior while at camp.

## Second occurrence

The camp educator will place the camper in “time-out”, which will be supervised by an Asbury Woods Staff member. The issue will be discussed with the parent.

Third occurrence Campers who consistently do not abide by the Camp Positive Behavior Plan will be removed from camp. No refunds will be issued if a child is removed from camp for behavior issues.
