Job goal: Assist with daily operation of the nature center including presenting public and group programs, operating the gift shop, maintaining live animal exhibits, and assisting with nature camp extended care hours.

Performance responsibilities:

- 1. Develop and present public and group programs on environmental topics for adults and children.
- 2. Staff Welcome Center and assist visitors in the nature center, answer phones, and ring up sales in the gift shop.
- 3. Care for live animals on exhibit including feeding animals and cleaning cages. Training will be provided.
- 4. Maintain supplies needed for programs and exhibits.
- 5. Work with other naturalists as a team to maintain daily operation of the nature center seven days a week.
- 6. Assist with maintenance and landscaping, as needed.
- 7. Work with staff and volunteers in presenting programs and maintaining live animal exhibits.
- 8. Supervise and work with children during nature camp extended care on an as needed basis.
