What is a Camp Assistant?

Camp Assistants are <u>volunteers</u> who help Camp Counselors during summer camps offered by Asbury Woods. This position is an opportunity for those who are selected to gain practical experience working with children, develop teambuilding skills, meet new people, learn about nature, and earn service hours.

Who can be a Camp Assistant? Any student that is entering 9th grade through college and is age 14 or older.

Please note: We do not accept those completing court ordered service for our Camp Assistant positions.

What are the commitments and responsibilities of a Camp Assistant?

- Submit a complete application to Sarah Bennett, Asbury Woods' Director of Education, at sbennett@asburywoods.org or drop it off at 4105 Asbury Rd.
- The assistant, not their parent, should register on our Volunteer Matrix https://aw.volunteermatrix.com. It is okay if the parent's email address is used.
- Sign up for the volunteer shifts you want.
- Attend a camp assistant training before your first volunteer shift.
- Show up <u>on time</u> for <u>every day</u> of the camp that you are assigned.
- Assist the Asbury Woods staff with duties such as: helping the campers with their crafts, assisting with
 activities, preparing craft materials, cleaning up, modeling positive behaviors and excitement for
 nature, sweeping, and any additional jobs assigned by the camp staff.
 - Camp Assistants <u>will not</u> be responsible for teaching lessons, leading groups, or disciplining campers.
- Camp Assistants are expected to always demonstrate professional behavior in regard to cell phone use, dress, punctuality, following directions, and interactions with campers.
 - All Camp Assistants are expected to dress for daily outdoor activity, including appropriate walking/hiking footwear.
 - All Camp Assistants will be expected to sign a professional behavior agreement.
 - Camp Assistants who will be over the age of 18 while volunteering are required to obtain federal and state child abuse clearances.
